Gabrielle D'Angelo is a New York based artist currently working in Brooklyn. Her work is primarily abstract and focuses on materials' ability to expand articulations of the self, a body, a position. While her work touches on histories of modernism, minimalism, and color field painting, it makes a case for these histories under the lens of feminism as she references the domestic and decorative within these histories. She makes both

visual and movement-based work.

Gabrielle received her BFA from The Cooper Union in 2011 and her MFA from The Yale School of Art in 2019. She has received the Ely Harwood Schless Memorial Fund Price and the A.A Low Fund Prize. Gabrielle has taken part in residencies at Atlantic Center for the Arts, LaMama, Chez Bushwick, and Cora Dance. She has performed at Dixon Place, the HERE Center Performance Mix Festival, Movement Research at Judson Church, The Center for Performance Research, and Beam Center. Her paintings have been shown at Green Gallery, Treasure Town, and Chashama 461 Gallery. She is currently working towards a show at Steve Turner gallery in LA.
